Wishing you a Merry Christmas and a Wonderful New Year from our family to yours!






'Tis the season to be jolly, Fa la la la la, la la la la.


Fill the meadcup, drain the barrel, Fa la la la la, la la la la.







# Sweet tidings to you

We hope your holidays are a treat with these Homemade Snickerdoodle Cookies

- 1 Cup Soft Shortening Butter Flavored
- 1 1/2 Cups Granulated White Sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 2 3/4 Cups Sifted All Purpose Flour
- 2 Tsp. Cream of Tartar 1 Tsp Baking Soda
- 1/2 Tsp Salt
- 2 Tbsp Cinnamon
- 2 Tbsp Sugar



### **Directions:**

Stir together Sifted flour, Cream of tartar, Baking soda, Salt

Mix the wet ingredients with the dry ingredients slowly. Mix well.

Refrigerate the combined dough for 1 hour.

Roll into 1-1.5" balls.

Roll the balls in the cinnamon and sugar and coat well.

Place balls 2" apart on ungreased cookie sheet (or use silicone baking mat).

Bake until lightly browned, but still soft.

375 Degrees for about 7 minutes

Pull cookies out of oven - let sit 3-5 minutes before transferring them to a cookie sheet.
